Previewing Next Week's Lesson Brings 'Em Back

How to get your students excited about coming back next week

- 1. Tell him what he's going to miss if he skips next week.
- 2. Give him an assignment [to write, to think about, or to make a decision]
 - a problem he needs to solve
 - a question he may want answered
 - something which may cause him to invite a friend
 - some <u>issue</u> he needs to resolve
- 3. Give homework: even if only one kid or an adult does the homework, it is valuable to him
 - * read a chapter
 - * memorize a verse
 - * make a list
 - * read an article, chapter, pamphlet, handout
 - * have him <u>summarize</u> what was taught in class [Tell them, "I'm going to pick a name out of a hat next and have that person talk for two minutes about what we learn today. Pez candy for a prize."]
 - * "Evaluate me. Tell me 2 things. What you liked best about me last week, and one thing I could do better."
 - * make a chart of. . . . [Snickers for any chart you bring to class]
 - * talk to your parents about. . . .
 - * check out a website
 - * "Argue in your own mind about what I said."
