Meredith only did Sunday School homework for one year. It was fifth grade. That was the year the phone rang every Saturday afternoon. Meredith's Sunday school teacher called all of her students every week. She prayed for every one of those girls and did everything she knew to encourage them to love the LORD and obey Him. So she set aside time every Saturday to call each one.

At the end of each Sunday school class she gave the a homework assignment. There was a Scripture portion to read each day, several questions to answer, and attitudes to think about. When she would call Meredith, the Sunday school teacher would ask about a half dozen questions, and ask her to say her memory verses as well as she could. Then she'd pray for her, and tell her she loved her. When they were finished she'd hang up.

Meredith's life changed that year. She had a teacher who cared!
