

## HOW TO. . .pass on a passion to reach lost friends

### MUFs = My Unsaved Friends

- \* Make a poster with the names of M.U.Fs on it [*My Unsaved Friends*]. Pray aloud for those relatives, schoolmates, fellow workers, and neighbors from time to time. Hang the poster up in a prominent place.
- \* Speak often about opportunities you've taken to talk to people about Jesus.
- \* Tell the class about people you have explained salvation to, or given tracts to.
- \* Invite kids to follow you around and listen after a meeting when you chat with kids about their salvation.
- \* When you are witnessing "together," ask him to tell the unsaved person how he himself was saved. Where? When? Who was with him? What he remembers? And a verse.
- \* Take two kids to a park or a walk down the street to find other kids [*or even old ladies*] to tell about Jesus.
  - Go to an old folks facility and talk to the people sitting on the porch. *They always listen.*
  - Take a couple friends to a sporting event [*or go with their families*].
  - If he just wants to listen and not talk, teach him to pray for you while you speak.
- \* Pass on a passion for the lost. He'll learn that some people don't want to listen and others are eager.
- \* Teach him to leave tracts with people with a kind word. He can learn to ask people to read tracts to him aloud and then ask questions. He can just pass them out to people and ask, "Did you receive your 'Heaven Test'?"
- \* Keep them supplied [*but not overloaded*] with tracts.
- \* Talk about those who have come to you class who have recently trusted Christ as their Savior.
