Giving a Public (or an individual) Invitation

- 1. "Do you believe Jesus died for you?"
- 2. "Do you believe His promise that you will have eternal life if you trust Him?" *His promise is in John 3.16 "whosoever believeth..."*
- 3. "If I trust in Him, and believe that he died for me, do I have eternal life in heaven?"
- 4. "Are you believing in Him right now?"
- 5. "Where will you go when you die? ☐ Heaven ☐ Hell

6. "How do you know?" (the answer is a sentence, not just a word)

SECOND KEY QUESTION

7. "What does the Bible say?"

NOW IS THE TIME TO ENCOURAGE THE CHILD TO PRAY—after he is certain of his salvation and knows he has a home in heaven and is depending on a Bible verse for his salvation.

Praying to Jesus does not save. Faith saves.

8. "Why don't you thank Jesus right now for dying for you and giving you a home in His perfect heaven?"

After a child puts his trust in Jesus as his individual Savior, he should understand the Gospel clearly enough to be able to go home and tell his parents:

- 1. God has never sinned in His whole life
- 2. I know I've done things wrong
- 3. Being good doesn't take anybody's sin away
- 4. I believe Jesus died for my own sin
- 5. The Bible tells me so, and there's a promise that tells me I have eternal life.
- 6. Mom & Dad, will you believe in Jesus the same way, please!
