Where are you on this continuum?

Group A - *The Unsaved*

#1. **UNBELIEVERS** who have never heard or understood

#2. **PROFESSING “BELIEVERS”** who are trusting in their own good works

#3. **REBELLIOUS DISBELIEVERS** who know the truth and reject it with eyes wide open

Group B - *The Saved*

#4. Baby Christians, still on milk
Walking in the Spirit the best they know how

#5. Teenage Christians, old enough to feed themselves, not mature enough to guide others well
Walking in the Spirit the best they know how

#6. Mature Believers, steady diet of meat & truly spiritual
Has logged years walking in the Spirit

All it takes is sorrow, repentance, & confession to be restored and to return to *walking in the Spirit*.

- complaining Spirit
- habitual lying
- causing strife
