## THE 5 or 7 WELL-KNOWN WARNINGS

3,7-19 slipping, drifting from the Word hard heart, walking away unbelief, missing the Rest 5.11-6.12 dullness, immaturity, apathy willful sin bitterness 12,25-29 bitterness, turning away

- Heb 4:16 Let us therefore <u>come boldly unto the throne of grace</u>, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.
- Heb 12:1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, <u>let us lay aside every weight</u>, and the <u>sin</u> which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us.
- Heb 12:2 <u>Looking unto Jesus</u> the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Heb 12:5 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, <u>despise not thou the chastening of the Lord</u>, nor faint when thou art rebuked of Him.
- Heb 13:1 Let brotherly love continue.
- Heb 13:2 Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.
- Heb 13:3 Remember them that are in bonds, as bound with them; and them which suffer adversity, as being yourselves also in the body.
- Heb 13:5 <u>Let your conversation be without covetousness</u>; and <u>be content</u> with such things as ye have: for He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- Heb 13:7 Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the Word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation.
- Heb 13:9 Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein.
- Heb 13:17 Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.
