Some Differences Between Bible and Quran

- 2. No predictions of future events on earth.
- 3. No contemporaries of Muhammed are mentioned.
- 4. Very few stories. Mostly formal teaching.
- 5. Written within a 20-year span, [Bible took 1600 years]
- 6. One writer, [Bible = 40 writers]
- 7. Muhammed claims his message came from angels, [Bible writers claim message came directly from God]
