PRAYER MENTIONED 22X IN THE BOOK OF ACTS

1.14 apostles dorm room, 120 men & women gathered for prayer

These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren.

1.24,25 apostles prayed over selection of 12th apostles

They prayed, and said, Thou, Lord, which knowest the hearts of all men, shew whether of these two thou hast chosen.

2.42 prayer after 3,000 saved

They continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

3.1 Peter & John at Temple at hour of prayer, 3 pm

Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour.

4.24,31 Peter & John released from jail after healing lame man

When they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is: 31 and when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

- 6.4 apostles committed to ministry of prayer & the Word, occasion = appointment of 7 deacons We will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word.
- 6.6 apostles laid hands on deacons

Whom they set before the apostles: and when they had prayed, they laid their hands on them.

7.58,59 Stephen prays as he is being stoned

(They) cast him out of the city, and stoned him: and the witnesses laid down their clothes at a young man's feet, whose name was Saul. 59 And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.

8.15 Peter prays for indwelling of Holy Spirit

Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost:

8.24 Simon asks for apostles to pray for him

Then answered Simon and said, Pray ye to the Lord for me, that none of these things which ye have spoken come upon me.

9.40 Peter prays over corpse of Tabitha

Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning him to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up.

10.2,30 Cornelius, centurion, prays continually

Cornelius said, "Four days ago I was fasting until this hour; and at the ninth hour I prayed in my house, and, behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing."

10.9 Peter prays at lunchtime

On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the sixth hour (noon).

12.5,12 prayer for Peter at Mary's house

Peter therefore was kept in prison, but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him.

- 13.3 elders fast and pray for Barnabas & Saul and ordain them to go

 When they had fasted and prayed and laid their hands on them, they sent them away.
- 14.23 Paul & Silas pray and ordain elders in Turkey (Galatia)

 When they had ordained them elders in every church, and had prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they believed.
- 16.13 Lydia & the unsaved Jewish girls at a riverside prayer session

 On the sabbath we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted thither.
- 16.13 Paul & Silas pray and are interrupted by demon possessed girl

 It came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:
- 20.36 Paul and Ephesus' elders pray before he leaves town

 When he had thus spoken, he kneeled down, and prayed with them all.
- 21.5 Paul and church leaders from Tyre pray on the beach as he leaves

 When we had accomplished those days, we departed and went our way; and they all brought us on our way, with wives and children, till we were out of the city: and we kneeled down on the shore, and prayed.
- 27.35 shipwreck, Paul prays before passengers eat

 When he had thus spoken, he took bread, and gave thanks to God in presence of them all: and when he had broken it, he began to eat.
- 28.8 Paul prays just before he heals Publius' dad

 It came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and of a bloody flux: to whom Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him, and healed him.
