

PHARAOH SAID, “GO!” SIX TIMES

- a: Pharaoh hardens his own heart
- b. Pharaoh says, “I have sinned!”

“GO!”

#1 after the FROGS

Exodus 8:8 Then Pharaoh called for Moses and Aaron, and said, Intreat the LORD, that he may take away the frogs from me, and from my people; and I will let the people **GO**, that they may do sacrifice unto the LORD.

#2 after the GNATS

Exodus 8:25,28 Pharaoh called for Moses and for Aaron, and said, Go ye, sacrifice to your God in the land. 28 And Pharaoh said, I will let you **GO**, that ye may sacrifice to the LORD your God in the wilderness; only **ye shall not go very far away**: intreat for me.

#3 after the HAIL

Exodus 9:28 Intreat the LORD (for it is enough) that there be no more mighty thunderings and hail; and I will let you **GO**, and ye shall stay no longer.

#4 after the LOCUSTS

Exodus 10:8,11 Moses and Aaron were brought again unto Pharaoh: and he said unto them, **GO**, serve the LORD your God: but who are they that shall go? 11 Not so: go now **ye that are men** (*males*).

#5 after the DARKNESS

Exodus 10:24 Pharaoh called unto Moses, and said, **GO** ye, serve the LORD; only **let your flocks and your herds be stayed**: let your little ones also go with you.

#6 after the DEATH OF THE FIRSTBORN

Exodus 12:31,32 He called for Moses and Aaron by night, and said, Rise up, and get you forth from among my people, both ye and the children of Israel; and **GO**, serve the LORD, as ye have said. 32 Also take your flocks and your herds, as ye have said, and be gone; and bless me also.

a. PHAROH HARDENED HIS OWN HEART, 6X

Exodus 7:22 The magicians of Egypt did so with their enchantments: and **Pharaoh's heart was hardened**, neither did he hearken unto them; as the LORD had said.

Exodus 8:15 When Pharaoh saw that there was respite, **he hardened his heart**, and hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Exodus 8:19 Then the magicians said unto Pharaoh, This is the finger of God: and **Pharaoh's heart was hardened**, and he (*Pharaoh*) hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Exodus 8:32 **Pharaoh hardened his heart** at this time also, neither would he let the people go.

Exodus 9:7 Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the **heart of Pharaoh was hardened**, and he did not let the people go.

Exodus 9:34 And when **Pharaoh** saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he sinned yet more, and **hardened his heart**, he and his servants.

GOD HARDEDEN PHARAOH'S HEART, 8X (*poured concrete around Pharaoh's decision*)

Exodus 7:13 He hardened Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Exo 9:12 The LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh, and he hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had spoken unto Moses.

Exodus 10:1 The LORD said unto Moses, Go in unto Pharaoh: for I have hardened his heart, and the heart of his servants, that I might shew these my signs before him:

Exodus 10:20 The LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go.

Exodus 10:27 The LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, and he would not let them go.

Exodus 11:10 Moses and Aaron did all these wonders before Pharaoh: and the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go out of his land.

Exodus 14:8 The LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued after the children of Israel: and the children of Israel went out with an high hand.

b. Pharaoh said, "I HAVE SINNED!"

Exo 9:27 And Pharaoh sent, and called for Moses and Aaron, and said unto them, I have sinned this time: the LORD is righteous, and I and my people are wicked.

Exo 10:16,17 Then Pharaoh called for Moses and Aaron in haste; and he said, I have sinned against the LORD your God, and against you. 17 Now therefore forgive, I pray thee, my sin only this once, and intreat the LORD your God, that he may take away from me this death only.
